MONDAY 11.8 - Tel Aviv

- RABIN SQUARE

A main large public city square in the center of Tel Aviv that has become the site of numerous rallies, parades and other events. A memorial stands in the exact spot that Yitzhak Rabin was assisinated.

ROTHSCHILD BOULEVARD

Stroll down one of Tel Aviv's iconic streets, lined with Bauhaus buildings that give Tel Aviv the "White City" moniker.

OLD JAFFA WALKING TOUR

One of the world's oldest seaports now home to ancient ruins, a restored artists' quarter, and a multiethnic community of Muslims, Christians, and Jews.

- PALMACH MUSEUM

Learn about the strike-force arm of the Haganah, Israel's pre-State underground defense organization, through a multimedia experience.

OPTIONAL NEVE TZEDEK WALKING TOUR

The first Jewish neighborhood built outside the old city of Jaffa in 1887 that now boasts various restaurants, galleries, and designer shops, breathing life into this up-and-coming area of Tel Aviv.

ATLIT DETENTION CAMP

Where thousands of Jewish immigrants were imprisoned during the British Mandate upon arriving into Israel.

TISHBI WINERY

Offers stunning views of the lush surrounding vineyard. Enjoy a wine tasting and guided tour of the facilities as well as a light lunch.

CAESAREA

A former Roman capital of the region, this ancient city boasts archaeological excavations and ruins from the Crusader period, the historic aqueduct, and is the site of an old amphitheater, which has been restored and converted to a concert venue.

NACHALAT BINYAMIN AND CARMEL MARKET

A vibrant outdoor market with various venders selling original, handmade items of art, ceramics, jewelry, and more.

SPECIAL IN UNIFORM

An innovative program that integrates youth with special needs into the Israel Defense Forces (IDF) and assists in preparing them for career placement after army service.

AYALON INSTITUTE

A clandestine bullet factory established by the Haganah in 1945. As the largest bullet factory during that time, it produced 2.25 million bullets from 1946-1948, in complete secrecy.

THURSDAY 11.11 - Mitzpe Ramon / Be'er Sheva

- **SDE BOKER**

Site of the former home and gravesite of David Ben-Gurion, where he resided until he died in 1973.

BE'ER SHEVA RIVER PARK

The centerpiece of JNF's efforts to create a renaissance for the city. See how this urban renewal project has served as an anchor of tourism and recreation.

- LAUDER EMPLOYMENT CENTER

Assists with employment opportunities in the Negev and the rapid advancement of the city of Be'er Sheva.

DINNER WITH A MAKOM COMMUNITY

Groups of young people who move to underprivileged parts of the country and empower those places from within through a variety of projects involving employment, culture, and education.

FRIDAY 11.12 - Gaza Envelope / Jerusalem

- BREAKFAST AT THE HOTEL AND CHECKOUT
- HALUTZA

Located in the Northwest Negev less than a mile away from the Gaza border, Halutza was founded in 2005 by a group of families that left their homes during Israel's disengagement from Gaza. In partnership with JNF, Halutza's pioneers laid roads, created infrastructure and housing sites, planted crops, built fields of solar energy panels, and more.

SDEROT INDOOR RECREATION CENTER

A signature project that has provided a much-needed sense of normalcy for residents living in the hard-hit town of Sderot, located less than one mile from Gaza.

Take in the sweeping views of the city, and join a ceremony of Shehecheyanu, a blessing celebrating special occasions in thanks for new and special experiences and events.

At the hotel joined by Nefesh B'Nefesh Lone Soldiers, young Olim who volunteered to move to Israel and join the Israel Defense Forces (IDF).

Take a cable car up to Masada, the mountain fortress built by King Herod where religious zealots made their final stand against the Romans. Descend the mountain to the Dead Sea, the lowest place on Earth, to float in the buoyant waters and relax at the beach.

Site of the pivotal battle of the Six-Day War that led to the reunification of Jerusalem.
