Frequently Asked Questions about Registration, AMHSI, Travel Subsidies and Meals Conference Registration and Hotel Check-in

- JNF will provide accommodations to college students at the conference hotel. Please note, if you choose to make your own arrangements to stay elsewhere, JNF will NOT cover those costs.
- The College Summit sessions will be held at the Grand Hyatt Washington, located at 1000 H Street N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001.
- The deadline to register for College Summit is August 29, 2019. The registration fee is \$100. If you need to cancel your registration, the deadline to do so is July 26, 2019, in which you will receive a full refund of your registration fee. Any cancellations after this date will not be eligible for refund.
- Registration for JNF College Summit will take place at the Grand Hyatt Washington, beginning at 10:00 am on Friday, September 13. We recommend registering no later than 1:00 pm.
- Upon entering the hotel, proceed to check in with your luggage first, if the hotel room is not ready, baggage can be left at the bell desk to be delivered to the room at a later time.
- After hotel check-in proceed to pick up your credentials and conference materials at the JNF conference registration desk (different location from hotel check-in).
- Our program begins at 3:00 pm on Friday, September 13 and concludes at 3:00 pm on Sunday, September 15. JNF is not responsible for your accommodations or meals after the conclusion of the program.

Travel Subsidies

- Travel Subsidies are available for students traveling from within the East Coast region, including the Southeast, up to \$250
- If driving from Maryland, Virginia and Washington D.C., subsidies of \$0.525/mile will be granted up to \$125.
- Students traveling from the West (anything west of Chicago) up to \$400
- Flight, Bus and Mileage expenses are the only allowable reimbursement with receipts. Ground transportation, travel insurance, parking, baggage fees etc. will not be eligible for reimbursement.
- Travel subsidies must be submitted by September 3, 2019. Following the conference any outstanding receipts must be submitted no later than September 20, 2019.
