Immerse yourself in the bustling energy of Jerusalem's shuk (Hebrew for market). Taste delicious cheeses, pastries, spices, and more

- AMMUNITION HILL

Site of the pivotal battle of the Six-Day War that led to the reunification of Jerusalem.

Embark on a comprehensive walking tour including the historic Jewish & Christian Quarters; the Western Wall (known as the Kotel), and other fascinating sites.

The mountain fortress built by King Herod where religious zealots made their final stand against the Romans. Learn about Be Inscribed, JNF's new Torah Scroll Initiative. Have your own honorary letter written into a Torah by a Jewish Sofer (scribe).

DEAD SEA

Float in the buoyant waters and relax at the beach of the Dead Sea, the lowest place on Earth.

THURSDAY 5.27 – Northern Negev

BREAKFAST AT THE HOTEL AND CHECKOUT

■ BE'ER SHEVA RIVER PARK

The centerpiece of JNF's efforts to create a renaissance for the city. See how this urban renewal project has served as an anchor of tourism and recreation.

ALEH NEGEV-NAHALAT ERAN

A one-of-a-kind rehabilitative village in Southern Israel that provides high-level medical services and unparalleled care to individuals with severe cognitive and physical disabilities.

LUNCH IN THE AREA HALUTZA

Located in the Northwest Negev less than a mile away from the Gaza border, Halutza was founded in 2005 by a group of families that left their homes during Israel's disengagement from Gaza. In partnership with JNF, Halutza's pioneers laid roads, created infrastructure and housing sites, planted crops, built fields of solar energy panels, and more.

JNF'S SDEROT INDOOR RECREATION CENTER

A signature project that has provided a much-needed sense of normalcy for residents living in the hard-hit town of Sderot, located less than one mile from Gaza.

MAKOM COMMUNITY VISIT AND DINNER

Groups of young people who move to underprivileged parts of the country and empower those places from within through a variety of projects involved employment, culture, and education.

AYALON INSTITUTE

A clandestine bullet factory established by the Haganah in 1945. As the largest bullet factory during that time, it produced 2.25 million bullets from 1946-1948, in complete secrecy.

NACHALAT BINYAMIN MARKET

A vibrant outdoor market with various vendors selling original, handmade items of art, ceramics, jewelry and more. Enjoy free time to wander an.


SHABBAT DINNER

Learn about the strike-force arm of the Haganah, Israel's pre-State underground defense organization, through a multimedia experience.

WALKING TOUR OF NEVE TZEDEK

The first Jewish neighborhood built outside of the old city of Jaffa in 1887 that now boasts various restaurants, galleries, and designer shops, breathing life into this up-and-coming area of Tel Aviv.

MONDAY 5.31 – Coastal North

CAESAREA

A former Roman capital of the region, this ancient city boasts archaeological excavations and ruins from the Crusader period, the historic aqueduct, and is the site of an old amphitheater, which has been restored and converted to a concert venue.

TISHBI WINERY FOR LUNCH AND WINE TASTING

Offers stunning views of the lush surrounding vineyards. Enjoy a wine tasting and guided tour of the facilities.

ZICHRON YA'AKOV

A charming village and one of Israel's first modern settlements with stunning views of the Mediterranean shore and rich Zionist historu.

ATLIT DETENTION CAMP

Where thousands of Jewish immigrants were imprisoned during the British Mandate upon arriving into Israel.
