

# Succulent Planting Workshop Supplies List

*These supplies prepare you to create one planter pot*

## Succulents (Choose your favorite varieties!)

- 3 succulents (3" or 4" plants) **OR** 5 succulents (2" plants)

## Pot

- 10" Long x 5" Wide / 4" Deep **OR** 8" Long x 5" Wide / 4" Deep
- Pots **MUST** have drainage hole in the bottom.

## Window Screen

- One piece of window screen to cover the bottom of the pot

## Soil

- One bag (approximately 2 cubic feet) Cactus & Succulent Mix

## 2 Five Gallon Buckets

- One bucket should be filled halfway with water
- One bucket should be empty

**Water** - Access to water

## Trowel

- A small hand shovel for digging in pot and mixing soil

## Small Decorative Rocks

- About 1/4" in size. They can be glass or stones
- Rounded in shape is ideal
- These will serve both as a decorative finish as well as a practical purpose

**Scissors** - To cut screen to fit bottom of pot

**Chopsticks** - One pair of disposable wooden chopsticks

**Gloves** - Optional but recommended to protect your hands

**Apron** - Optional but recommended

**Newspaper** or something to cover table
