GALILEE CULINARY INSTITUTE BY JEWISH NATIONAL FUND-USA

Visit the site of the new Jewish National Fund Galilee Culinary Institute. Enjoy lunch and participate in a dedication with Chef and GCI by JNF-USA co-founder Lior Sercarz and others.

DINNER AT ATLIT DETENTION CAMP

Tour and have dinner outside where thousands of Jewish immigrants were imprisoned during the British Mandate upon arriving into Israel. Tour the barracks and restored Galina ship, an exact replica of the ship that once carried 122,000 "illegal" immigrants in defiance of the British blockade. See the new C-46 Commando Airplane, a replica of the plane used for an undercover operation in 1947 to fly over 150 Jews from Iraq in 1947.
